DENISON TILL ON TRACK WITH RARE LEGAL TRAINING ACCOLADE

A RARE accolade has been won by York law firm Denison Till for its legal training courses which are attended by hundreds of professionals in Yorkshire each year.

Denison Till, which runs a long-established programme of legal seminars and external and in-house training on issues ranging from human resources to property, has gained continuing professional development (CPD) accreditation from the Solicitors Regulation Authority (SRA), the regulatory body of the Law Society of England and Wales.

Achieving the quality-assurance accreditation as a training provider – a rare achievement for a law firm rather than a specialist training organisation – means that Denison Till's legal training is deemed to be suitable for all professionals, including other law firms.

Denison Till achieved accreditation for the CPD scheme, launched by the SRA in 1985, for criteria including the expertise of its legal trainers, the quality of handouts, the style of its training and for having clear delegate aims and objectives.

All UK solicitors who work more than 32 hours a week are encouraged to complete more than 16 hours CPD training a year of which 25 per cent must include participation in accredited training courses. Denison Till also trains a wide range of professionals, including accountants and chartered surveyors, who must complete CPD training as part of membership of their professional body.
